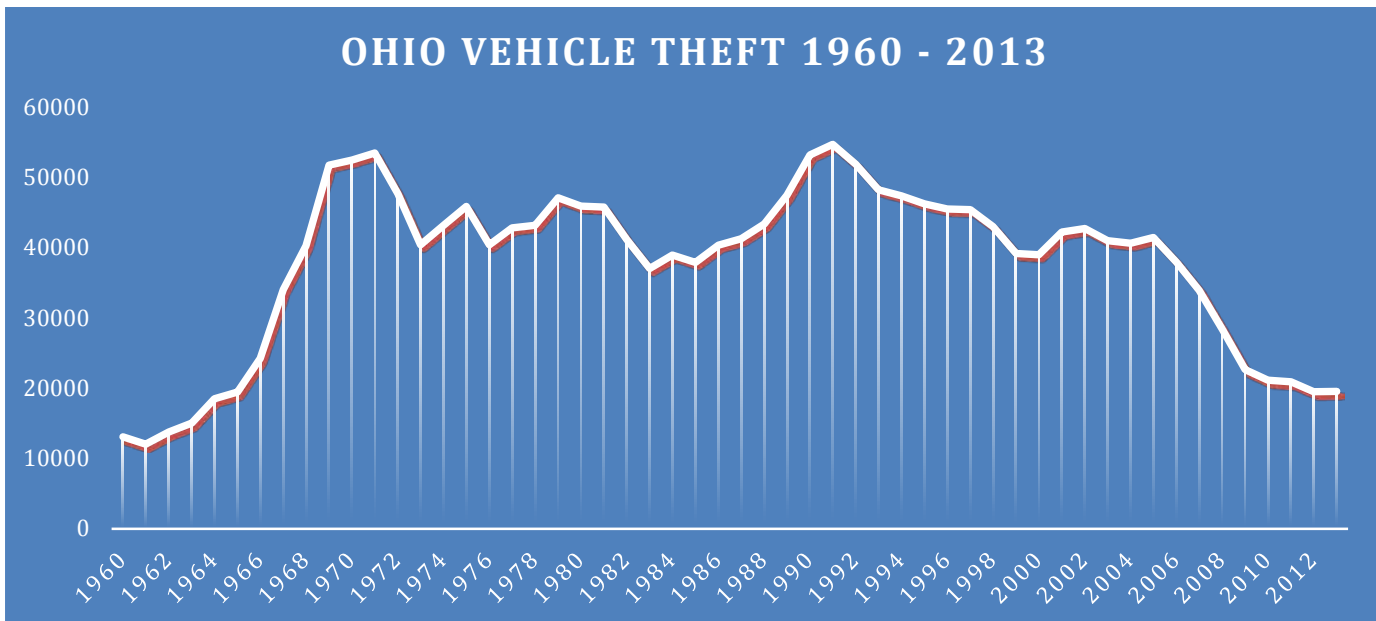


## Ohio statewide auto theft trend report
